The edge of the table was designed softly-curved to make it impossible

to resist touching it. Homogenous look of the tabletop and leg structure emphasizes the slender shape instead of material. Although the table is made of different materials, the color creates variation in sizes and heights allow to arrange these tables in groups.

The point of departure was a classic brick bond forming the cushion pattern.





